## Practices and Games:

- Team Practices: Usually, the team practices are held on Tuesday and Thursdays between hours of 5 pm to 9 pm, we have several designated practice locations based on the time of year the majority within the city of Downey. We will always make sure to let everyone know the location when it changes.
